No.	Name of the course	Course Description	ECTS
1.	Methodology of social research	The aim of the course is to provide knowledge in the field of sociology, social change and social differentiation necessary for critical thinking, analyzing socio-cultural reality and searching for social and cultural aspects of innovation, technology and change. By independently studying the texts and discussing them during the class, the students should have a good general understanding of the methodological issues.	3
2.	Care and social pedagogics	Social pedagogy is a field of knowledge dealing with the environmental and civilizational determinants of the course of educational processes. The aim of the course is to introduce students to the area of pedagogical knowledge illustrating the complexity of the processes of individual development and human formation in a complex and multidimensional social reality.	3
3.	Psychology of social behavior	The student will acquire basic knowledge, skills and competences necessary for a satisfactory and effective functioning in the society. Key issues of social psychology, important from the perspective of social work, will be discussed.	3
4.	Problems of the modern family	To acquaint students with the basic knowledge about the changes taking place in the contemporary Polish family, both in terms of its structure and functions. Indication of the factors (historical, cultural, economic, biomedical, political) conditioning these changes, and the classification and definition problems resulting from these changes.	3





5.	Supervision in social work	The aim of the course is to transfer basic knowledge in the field of social work supervision, concepts and applications as well as phenomena related to the supervision method, as well as elements of supervision management.	3
6.	Elaboration and implementation of a social project	Getting to know the social environment during social work. Basic methods of diagnosing the social environment. Learning how to write social projects in practice in accordance with the initial stages of the project.	3
7.	Law and administrative procedure in social assistance	The aim of the course is to present the basic issues of administrative procedure in social assistance. During the exercises, students will learn to prepare an administrative decision or an administrative decision.	3
8.	Workshop for a social worker	The student will acquire basic knowledge of the scientific disciplines forming the theoretical basis for social work necessary for further methodical work with the client. Will be able to analyze the phenomena indicating the need to obtain benefits from social assistance and apply the applicable administrative procedures for determining the right to social benefits.	3
9.	Crisis intervention	The aim of the course is to present issues related to crisis intervention. During the tutorials, students will learn to carry out a 6-step model of crisis intervention and the skills to help people in a crisis.	3
10.	Evaluation of the social project	Evaluation of a social project is a class that is to introduce the basic elements of knowledge and skills to design evaluation research in accordance with the methodological standards of this sub-discipline of applied social sciences that have developed over the hundred years of their existence. The subject therefore includes introductory knowledge about the motives and history of establishing evaluation at the beginning of the last century, then describes its applications in increasing the quality and effectiveness of social programs, including social projects with their social challenges, ethics of research activities and the basic principles of its implementation. The subject describes and introduces the basic skills of the evaluator in his research, animation and educational functions, taking into account the requirements of	3
